

## 2004 Troop Goals

1. As a part of the Boy Scout Program, each Scout continues to:
  - a) Build the desirable qualities of character,
  - b) Train in the responsibilities of participating citizenship, and
  - c) Develop personal fitness.
2. Each Scout, with parental approval, earns their respective religious emblem.
3. Each Scout contributes to the troop earning the National Quality Unit Award and National Camping Award for 20 Days of Yearly Camping
4. Each Scout contributes at least 12 hours of volunteer time as a part of "Service to America". These service hours are accomplished through our monthly scout workdays or service projects on campouts.
5. During their tenure as a Scout, each Scout earns the Boy Scout World Conservation Award and practices the principles of Leave No Trace Camping.
6. Each Scout advances by at least one rank per year.
7. Each Scout participates in the annual food drive for the Food bank of North Alabama.
8. Each Scout assists the program of our associated Cub Scout Pack.
9. Each Scout participates in Summer Camp.
10. Each Scout participates in some type of High Adventure (High Adventure Base, Advanced Junior Leader Training, Philmont, Florida Sea Base, Northern Tier) during his tenure in the troop.
11. Each Scout participates in at least five weekend camping events during the year.
12. Each Scout participates in the annual Fall fundraiser to the best of their ability. The Scout will participate in the fundraiser to:
  - a) Support Scouting
  - b) Pay for his activities and/or camping equipment in Scouting
13. Each Scout participates in the Spring fundraiser to the best of their ability. The Scout will participate in the fundraiser to support troop equipment purchases.
14. During their tenure as a Scout, each Scout will attend the Boy Scout National Jamboree or the Boy Scout World Jamboree.
15. Each Scout subscribes to Boys' Life.
16. The troop earns the Greater Alabama Council Honor Unit Award.
17. Each Patrol earns the National Honor Patrol Award.
18. Each Patrol earns the top award at Camporee.
19. The Troop earns the top award at Summer Camp.
