

Patrol Redistribution Form

As a part of completing the 1st Year Scouting, the 1st Year Scouts are normally distributed among the older patrols. This is also an opportunity to cross-level some of the Older Scouts in order to balance maturity, leadership skills, and technical skills.

PART 1: Answer the following question ONLY if you are a 1st Year Scout. If you are not a 1st Year Scout, go to PART 2.

Backpacking patrol members will be responsible for their own food - either as individuals or as a patrol.)
